We, as School Council, believe that your voice matters! As such, this newsletter explains all the actions we have taken this term as a result of the ideas you have raised.

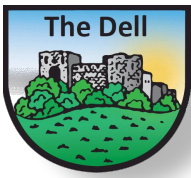
Remember, if you don't tell us about changes you want to see, we can't act upon them!

Helping charities:

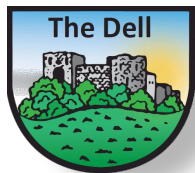
This year we have raised lots of money for lots of different charities. We hope to do the same next year, so watch this space for more charity events!

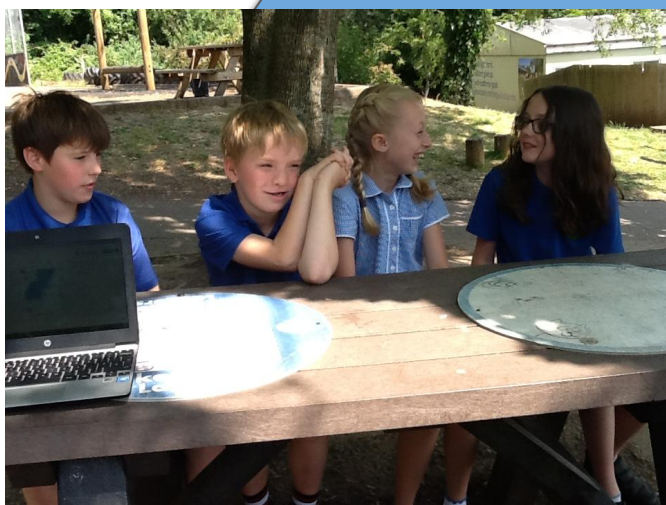


We are listening!
